#### ISMA CODING CORNER

In the last edition, I reported on the Welcome to Medicare Initial Preventive Physical Exam (IPPE). This article will address the Annual Wellness Visit available for Medicare patients with Part B coverage.

The Annual Wellness Visit (AWV) provides annual personalized prevention plan services (PPPS) to Part B Medicare beneficiaries. The AWV is not a physical exam but provides a health risk assessment which includes the following:

Establishing/reviewing the patient's medical and family histories, past medical and surgical histories, hospitalizations, injuries, and allergies. A review of medications, including supplements is performed.

Screening the patient for depression, whether new or past experiences.

Reviewing the patient's functional ability and level of safety based on activities of daily living, fall risk, home safety, and hearing impairment. This can be determined by direct observation or a screening questionnaire.

Assessment of height, weight, body mass index, and blood pressure.

Assessment for any cognitive impairment by direct observation or reports or concerns by family members or caretakers.

Once the risk assessment is performed, the physician can establish a written screening schedule for the patient based on health status and screening history, and age-appropriate preventive services covered by Medicare. Risk factors for mental health conditions, risk factors and treatment options related to these are recommended. Patients can be referred to such programs as fall prevention, nutrition, physical activity, tobacco-use cessation, and weight loss.

As part of the AWV, advance care planning can be discussed. This may include future care decisions, family members and others who may need to be included about care preferences, and explanation of advance directives which may involve the completion of standard forms.

As with the IPPE, medical codes for reimbursement by Medicare Part B are located in the Healthcare Common Procedural Coding System (HCPCS) manual. The codes for the AWV are:

G0438 – Annual wellness visit, including a personalized prevention plan of service (PPS), initial visit G0439 - Annual wellness visit, including a personalized prevention plan of service (PPS), subsequent visit

# EVA I. IRWIN, CMA (AAMA) MEDICAL ASSISTANT PROGRAM FUND

The Eva I. Irwin, CMA (AAMA) Medical Assistant Program Fund is to reflect the honors of those that had the privilege of knowing Eva I. Irwin, CMA (AAMA) and what being a Certified Medical Assistant (CMA-AAMA), a Medical Assistant Educator, and an accreditation surveyor of medical assistant programs for the American Association of Medical Assistants (AAMA).

The ISMA will award up to \$500 to an AAMA-accredited medical assisting program to help fund a piece of equipment, software, supplies, etc. Consideration for this award is based on the following criteria:

- Submission of the Eva I. Irwin, CMA (AAMA) Medical Assistant Program Fund application by the program chair, director, coordinator, or full-time faculty member.

**Subject: MANDATORY UPDATES TO STATE BYLAWS** 

At the 2017 Annual Convention of AAMA in Cincinnati, Ohio, the House of Delegates passed amendments to areas of the AAMA Bylaws which must be adhered to by state societies (mandated). Any changes required for compliance with the AAMA Bylaws do not require a vote of the state society, House of Delegates or assembly. State society delegates to AAMA voted on behalf of their state society membership at the AAMA House of Delegates to establish these mandated bylaws.

#### Following is the change that was made to the AAMA Bylaws:

ARTICLE VI: MEMBERSHIP, Section 2, Qualifications

- F. Student member
  - 1. Shall be enrolled in a medical assisting program.
  - 2. May choose a two-year student membership term or a one-year student membership term.
    - a. After a two-year student membership term, the member is then eligible only for either associate membership or active membership (if the member meets the active membership requirements).
    - b. After a one-year student membership term, the member is eligible for a second year of student membership as long as the member renews during the member's one-year student membership term. After the second-year of student membership, the member is then eligible only for either associate membership or active membership (if the member meets the active membership requirements).
    - c. No member is eligible for more than a total of two consecutive years of student membership.

As is required by the AAMA Bylaws, these revisions must be returned to the AAMA within 30 days of notification (30 days from the date on this email). After making these changes, please send a copy of the revised state bylaws to me (preferably by email attachment or fax), with a copy to Kathy Langley at the Executive Office (klangley@aama-ntl.org). (If you need to send them in hard copy via regular mail, please send them to Kathy Langley, and she will forward them to me.)

Once the revisions have been reviewed and found to be correct you will receive a letter of compliance.
