Tobacco and alcohol use in the 6-12 grades has decreased 13% since 1993.
- Website Development **Pam Neu, CMA (AAMA)** Progress is being made in updating the website. The notification of our meeting cancellation was made within hours. The calendar will be updated with meeting notifications provided by the chapters.
- Membership **Jeni Begley, CMA (AAMA)** reported that we have 1,097 members.
- Procedure Manual **Jane Seelig CMA-A (AAMA)** reported that the update is nearly complete having been submitted to the PIPS for review. There will be a separate tab on the website for the example materials such as forms and reports.
