#### ISMA CODING CORNER

The 2022 ICD-10-CM code changes have been released and will take effect on October 1, 2021. The proposed updates includes 153 new diagnosis codes, 22 revised codes, and 30 invalid codes. The most significant changes include the addition of new codes for cough, low back pain, and cannabis poisoning. There are several new codes for esophageal polyp, Sjogren syndrome, and two new codes for malignant neoplasm of bilateral ovaries and secondary malignant neoplasm of bilateral ovaries.

A sample of new ICD-10-CM codes are:

T40.715 – Adverse effect of cannabis

T80.82xS – Complication of immune effector cellular therapy, sequela

U09 - Post COVID-19 condition

Z71.85 – Encounter for immunization safety counseling

Z92.85 – Personal history of cellular therapy (Note: Cellular therapy is the transplantation of human cells to replace or repair damaged tissue and/or cells. This is a new technology with innovative products to treat a variety of diseases and conditions).

The new codes for cough will provide data about specific types of coughs. These are:

R05.1 – Acute cough

R05.2 – Subacute cough

R05.3 - Chronic cough

R05.4 – Cough syncope (fainting – common in patients with severe COPD and asthma)

R05.8 – Other specified cough

R05.9 – Unspecified cough

New codes for 2022 also include:

R35.81 – Nocturnal polyuria

R35.89 - Other polyuria with a specific description

R45.88 — Non-suicidal self-harm, such as self-injury and self-mutilation but **without** suicidal

Intent. (The injury would also be coded.)

M54.50 – Low back pain, unspecified

M54.51 – Vertebrogenic low back pain

M54.50 – Other low back pain (not otherwise specified)
